AN ACT

To authorize the City of Marlborough to fill Vacancies in its Sewerage Construction Committee.

[Senate No. 241 as amended and passed to be engrossed.]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any vacancy occurring in the
2 sewerage construction committee of the city of
3 Marlborough, elected by the city council, may
4 be filled by said city council by concurrent
5 vote at any time for the unexpired term,
6 and any member of said committee elected as
7 aforesaid, may be removed by the city council for
8 sufficient cause.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
