AN ACT

Relating to Fenders and Guards for Street Railway Cars.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and sixty-
2 four of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
3 ninety, entitled "an act relating to fenders and
4 guards for street railway cars," is hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
