AN ACT

To authorize the Transfer of the Inmates of the Industrial School at Lawrence to the Truant School for the County of Essex.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The superior court may, after the establish-
2 ment of a truant school in and for the county of
3 Essex and upon the application of the county
4 commissioners of said county, make such orders
5 as to it may seem proper to cause any person or
6 persons confined under sentence in the industrial
7 school at Lawrence to be transferred to said
8 truant school, and the person or persons so trans-
9 ferred shall serve the remainder of the term of
10 their respective sentences in such truant school
11 in the same manner as if originally committed
12 thereto.
