### RESOLVE

In favor of the Soldiers' Messenger Corps.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to the disabled soldiers'  
3 employment bureau a sum not exceeding eight hundred  
4 dollars, the same to be expended under the direction of  
5 the adjutant-general. Three hundred dollars of said  
6 sum shall be allowed for superintendence of said bureau.
