AN ACT

To authorize the Albert Manufacturing Company to hold Real Estate within this Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Albert Manufacturing Com-
2 pany, a corporation established under the laws of
3 the province of New Brunswick and dominion
4 of Canada, upon complying with the provisions
5 of chapter three hundred and thirty, of the acts
6 of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four, and
7 chapter three hundred and forty-one, of the acts
8 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one, may
9 purchase, hold and convey, such real estate in
10 this Commonwealth as may be necessary for the
11 purpose of conducting its manufacturing business.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
