RESOLVE.

In Relation to the Topographical Survey and Map of Massachusetts.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding thir-
3 teen thousand and one hundred dollars, to be expended
4 for the following purposes, to wit: for continuing the
5 determination by triangulation of the boundary lines
6 of the cities and towns of this Commonwealth, and mark-
7 ing said boundary lines, a sum not exceeding eleven
8 thousand five hundred dollars, to include supplementing
9 topographical map and levelling; for selling and distrib-
10 uting maps, a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars,
11 and for instruments a sum not exceeding one hundred
12 dollars.
