### AN ACT

Relative to the Compensation of the Official Stenographer  
for the County of Middlesex.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter four hundred and  
2 fifty-two of the acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-  
3 three is hereby amended by striking out the words " All  
4 sums of money received for copies by any official steno-  
5 grapher for said county of Middlesex shall be paid into  
6 the treasury of said county."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
