AN ACT

To establish the Massachusetts Volunteers Fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. So much of the amounts remaining in
2 the bounty loan sinking fund transferred thereto, under
3 authority of chapter one hundred and twelve of the acts
4 of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, on account
5 of Massachusetts volunteers, returned allotments and
6 allotment rolls, shall be set aside by the treasurer and
7 receiver-general as a fund, to be known as the Massa-
8 chusetts volunteers fund, and shall be held in trust by
9 him, and paid out only in accordance with the provisions
10 of said chapter one hundred and twelve as aforesaid.
11 Said fund may be invested in the same manner as other
12 funds, and all income from its investments shall be added
13 to and become a part of said fund.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
