AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Winchester to elect a Board of Sewer Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Winchester, at any meet-
2 in g called for the purpose, may elect a board of sewer
3 commissioners, to consist of three persons, to hold office
4 for one year, two years and three years, respectively,
5 from the date of the meeting at which they are elected,
6 if the same is an annual meeting, and if they are elected
7 at a special meeting they shall hold office until one, two
8 and three years, respectively, from the annual meeting
9 next following their election, and in either case until
10 their successors are chosen; and at each annual town
11 meeting when the term of one of the said commissioners
12 expires said town shall elect one member of said board
13 to serve for three years, or until his successor is elected.
14 If a vacancy shall occur in said board said town may, at
15 any meeting called for the purpose, elect a person to fill
16 said vacancy. In all matters concerning drains and

17 sewers said board of commissioners shall have all the
18 powers and be subject to all the duties, liabilities and
19 penalties which are now conferred or imposed upon
20 sewer commissioners by the provisions of chapter four
21 hundred and seventeen of the acts of eighteen hundred
22 and ninety-three.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
