AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for Expenses of Investigating into the Question of a Water Supply for the City of Boston and its Suburbs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum hereinafter mentioned is
2 appropriated to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for
4 the purposes specified, to wit:—

5 For such expenses as may be necessary to carry
6 out the provisions of the act relative to procuring
7 a water supply for the city of Boston and its
8 suburbs, as provided for in chapter four hundred
9 and fifty-nine of the acts of the year eighteen
10 hundred and ninety-three, a sum not exceeding
11 twenty-five thousand dollars, the same to be in
12 addition to the fifteen thousand dollars appro-
13 priated by chapter four hundred and eighty of
14 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
15 three.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
