[Bill accompanying petition of W. F. SPALDING. Liquor Law.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-four.

AN ACT

In Relation to Sureties upon Bonds given in connection
with the issue of Licenses for the sale of Intoxicating
Liquors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No person, firm or corporation shall be
2 accepted as surety upon more than ten bonds given under
3 the provisions of section thirteen of chapter one hundred
4 of the public statutes. Each such surety shall make a
5 written statement, under oath, that he is not a surety
6 upon more than nine other bonds given under the pro-
7 visions of said section, and such statement shall be kept
8 on file with the bond.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
