AN ACT

To authorize the County Commissioners of Bristol County to borrow a Sum of Money for the Purpose of Completing the New Court House at Taunton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The county commissioners of the county of Bristol
2 are hereby authorized to borrow on the credit of the
3 county a sum not to exceed sixty thousand dollars
4 and expend the same for the purpose of completing and
5 furnishing the new court house at Taunton, this sum
6 being in addition to that now authorized by chapter one
7 hundred and nineteen of the year eighteen hundred and
8 ninety-one.
