### AN ACT

Providing that the City Engineer of the City of Brockton shall be elected for a Term of Three Years.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city council of the city of Brockton  
2 shall as soon after their organization as may be con-  
3 venient, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five and  
4 triennially thereafter, elect by joint ballot in convention  
5 a city engineer, who shall hold his office for the term of  
6 three years next ensuing and until his successor is elected  
7 and qualified. Such officer may be removed and vacan-  
8 cies in his office filled and his compensation fixed as pro-  
9 vided by section fourteen of chapter one hundred and  
10 ninety-two of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
11 eighty-one, in the case of other officers elected by said  
12 city council.

1 SECT. 2. Section one of chapter two hundred and  
2 forty-three of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
3 eighty-five is hereby repealed; but such repeal shall not  
4 affect the city engineer now in office or an engineer  
5 appointed before the first day of January in the year  
6 eighteen hundred and ninety-five to fill a vacancy in said  
7 office.
