AN ACT

To Change the Name of Court Montgomery, Number Six Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-six, Ancient Order of Foresters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The name of Court Montgomery, number
2 six thousand three hundred eighty-six, Ancient Order of
3 Foresters, is hereby changed to Court Montgomery, num-
4 ber six thousand three hundred eighty-six, Ancient Order
5 of Foresters of America.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
