In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-four.

AN ACT

To authorize the Holyoke Street Railway Company to construct and operate its Railway over Private Property and acquire Said Property by Purchase or Lease.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Holyoke Street Railway Company
2 may construct and operate its railway over such private
3 property as it may acquire by purchase or lease within
4 the cities and towns where its construction and operation
5 are now authorized, subject to the limitations prescribed
6 by section two of this act, and subject also to such con-
7 ditions and limitations as may be imposed by the board
8 of aldermen of the cities or by the selectmen of the
9 towns in which its tracks are located. It may acquire,

10 by purchase or lease, all necessary real estate for its
11 power stations and other uses incidental to the proper
12 maintenance of its railway.

1 SECT. 2. The location of said street railway, outside
2 of public streets and highways, shall not exceed fifty
3 feet in width, except for station purposes.
