### AN ACT

To amend an Act authorizing the Taking of the Remaining  
Portion of the Old Cemetery in the Town of Fairhaven.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter three hundred  
2 fifty-one of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
3 eighty-seven is hereby amended so as to read:—

4 *Section 4.* This act shall take effect upon its passage,  
5 but shall become void unless said company shall complete  
6 the occupation thereof by its road and the erection of said  
7 depot and station thereon within seven years from the  
8 passage of this act.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
