AN ACT

To extend the Powers of the Newton Theological Institution.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECTION 1. The Newton theological institution, a
2 corporation under the laws of this Commonwealth, is
3 granted, in addition to the powers conferred by chapter
4 ninety-six of the act of eighteen hundred and twenty-six,
5 authority to confer degrees for special attainments in
6 theological learning or important contributions to theo-
7 logical literature.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
