## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

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In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-four.

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### AN ACT

To incorporate the Newtonville Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1    SECTION 1.    John W. Weeks, John C. Holman,  
2 George W. Morse, Jasper N. Keller, Horace B. Parker,  
3 Samuel Farquhar and James W. French, their associates  
4 and successors, are hereby made a corporation under the  
5 name of the Newtonville trust company.

1    SECT. 2.    Such company shall have authority to  
2 establish and maintain a safe deposit and trust company  
3 in that part of the city of Newton known as Newtonville,  
4 with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all  
5 the rights, duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in  
6 the existing general laws, and laws which may hereafter  
7 be passed pertaining to such corporations.

1    SECT. 3.    This act shall take effect upon its passage.
