RESOLVE

In favor of Mary Waterman.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid to Mary
2 Waterman, executrix of the will of Anthony Waterman,
3 of the city of Boston, the sum of twelve hundred twenty-
4 nine dollars and fifty cents, said sum to be paid from the
5 harbor compensation fund, being an assessment made by
6 the harbor and land commissioners, under chapter nine-
7 teen of the Public Statutes, for displacement of tide-
8 water, by building a wharf on Mystic river, in the city
9 of Boston, Charlestown district. This assessment was
10 paid by said Mary Waterman on about the twentieth of
11 December, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety, and
12 was paid into and became a part of the harbor compen-
13 sation fund.
