AN ACT

Authorizing Advances to the Sergeant-at-Arms from the
Treasury of the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There may be advanced to the sergeant-
2 at-arms, under the provisions of chapter one hundred and
3 seventy-nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
4 eighty-four, to meet the necessary and legitimate expen-
5 ditures made in behalf of the Commonwealth by him for
6 committees of the legislature while travelling under order
7 of the general court, an amount not exceeding two thou-
8 sand dollars at any one time.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
