AN ACT

Concerning the Admission of Certain Foreign Corporations
to do Business in this Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any corporation,
2 association, or organization of another state or country,
3 except life insurance companies as provided in chapter
4 two hundred fourteen of the acts of the year eighteen
5 hundred eighty-seven, to engage or continue in this
6 Commonwealth in any kind of business the transaction of
7 which by domestic corporations is not permitted by the
8 law of this Commonwealth.

9 Nor shall the commissioner of corporations, or the
10 insurance commissioner, or any other officer of the Com-
11 monwealth whose duty it is to examine and decide
12 whether a corporation, association or other organization
13 is privileged to file any papers under chapter three
14 hundred thirty of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
15 eighty-four, or chapter two hundred fourteen of the acts
16 of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, or chap-

17 ter four hundred twenty-one of the acts of the year
18 eighteen hundred and ninety, or chapter forty of the acts
19 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-two, or any act
20 amendatory of either, accept or file the charter, financial
21 statement or other papers, or accept appointment as
22 attorney for service for any corporation, association or
23 other organization doing a business, the transaction of
24 which by domestic corporations is not then permitted by
25 the law of this Commonwealth.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon the first day
2 of January in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five.
