RESOLVE

Providing for Painting and for Certain Repairs to the State House.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding four
3 thousand dollars, to be expended by the state house con-
4 struction commissioners for the following purposes, to
5 wit: a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars for
6 painting the outside of the state house, the color to be
7 yellow, with white trimmings, to conform as nearly as
8 possible to the color of the state house extension, and a
9 sum not exceeding one thousand dollars for repairing the
10 roof of the state house.
