RESOLUTIONS

Relative to the Tariff on Sumatra Tobacco.

1 *Resolved*, That the senate and house of representa-
2 tives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, deeming
3 a speedy solution of the tariff issue indispensable to the
4 prosperity of the nation, request the senators and repre-
5 sentatives from this Commonwealth in the Congress of
6 the United States to use their influence to sustain our
7 American protective system, and especially to maintain
8 Schedule F of the McKinley bill, which relates to the
9 importation of Sumatra tobacco.

1 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions, properly
2 attested, be transmitted by the secretary of the Com-
3 monwealth to the presiding officers of both branches of
4 congress and also to the senators and representatives in
5 congress from this Commonwealth.
