AN ACT

To authorize the Lowell and Suburban Street Railway Company to Extend its Tracks and to Supply Electricity.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Lowell and Suburban Street Railway
2 Company is hereby authorized and empowered to con-
3 struct, maintain and use its railway in such of the high-
4 ways or townways of the towns of Westford, Bedford,
5 Burlington and Wilmington, in the county of Middlesex,
6 from the boundary line between Tewksbury and Andover
7 in the county of Essex, easterly to Haggetts pond, over
8 the highway which runs from Lowell to Andover, and is
9 a continuation of Andover street in Lowell, as locations
10 therefor may hereafter from time to time be granted by
11 the boards of selectmen of said respective towns.

1 SECT. 2. Said Lowell and Suburban Street Railway
2 Company is hereby authorized and empowered to supply
3 electricity for a motive power for street railway purposes
4 in any city or town in which said company is or may be

5 authorized to locate its said railway, and for said pur-
6 pose of supplying electricity as a motive power, to con-
7 struct and maintain poles, trolley-wires, stay-wires and
8 other devices for conducting electricity in such of the
9 streets, highways or townways of any of said cities and
10 towns whereon it may be authorized so to do respectively
11 by the boards of aldermen of said cities, or the selectmen
12 of said towns.

1 SECT. 3. All locations and rights heretofore granted
2 to said Lowell and Suburban Street Railway Company,
3 or to any corporation which it may have acquired under
4 authority of law, by the board of aldermen of the city of
5 Lowell, and the selectmen, respectively, of the towns
6 of Dracut, Chelmsford and Billerica, are hereby ratified
7 and confirmed, and shall be deemed and taken to have
8 been duly granted under authority of law.
