AN ACT

Relative to the Inspection of Milk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No producer of milk shall be liable to prosecution on
2 the ground that the milk produced by him is not of good
3 standard quality, unless the milk alleged not to be of
4 such quality was taken upon the premises or while in
5 the possession or under the control of the producer by
6 an inspector of milk or by the agents of the dairy bureau
7 or state board of health, or collector of samples duly
8 authorized by such inspector, and a sealed sample of the
9 same given to the producer.
