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## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

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In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-five.

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### AN ACT

Relative to the Election of Members of the Board of Public Works of the City of New Bedford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The term of office of the members of  
2 the board of public works of the city of New Bedford,  
3 appointed by the mayor of said city, shall expire on the  
4 first day of May in the year eighteen hundred and  
5 ninety-six, and at the annual municipal election held in  
6 said city in the present year there shall be elected three  
7 members of said board of public works, one for one  
8 year, one for two years and one for three years from the  
9 first day of May in the year eighteen hundred and  
10 ninety-six, and until their successors are elected and

11 qualified. And thereafter at each annual municipal  
12 election in said city one member of said board shall be  
13 elected for three years, in place of the member whose  
14 term expires on the first day of May next following.  
15 The salary of each of said elected members of said board  
16 shall be seven hundred and fifty dollars a year, to be  
17 paid out of the treasury of said city. After the expira-  
18 tion of the term of office of the present appointed mem-  
19 bers of said board no members of said board shall be  
20 appointed by the mayor except in case of vacancies ; but  
21 vacancies shall continue to be filled as at present  
22 provided.

1. SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
