AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Care and Supervision of the Province Lands at Provincetown.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of thirty-five hundred
2 dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of
3 the treasury of the Commonwealth from the or-
4 dinary revenue, for the care and supervision of
5 the province lands in the town of Provincetown,
6 to be expended under the direction of the har-
7 bor and land commissioners. [Acts 1893, chap.
8 480.]

(Appropriation 1894, \$3,000.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
