AN ACT

Relative to the Establishments for the Disposal of Garbage.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Establishments for the disposal of gar-
2 bage or offal by process of heat, electricity, or by
3 heat and electricity, where the amount of garbage or offal
4 so disposed of, or to be disposed of, exceeds in amount
5 five hundred pounds during any one day, or at any one
6 time, whether said establishment exists by authority of
7 any board of health, or by the action of any city or town
8 government, shall be considered an offensive trade, and
9 shall be subject to all the laws of the Commonwealth
10 regulating and governing licenses for permission to carry
11 on offensive trades.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
