[Bill accompanying the petition of the selectmen of the towns of West Newbury and Merrimac for the reconstruction of a part of Rocks Bridge over the Merrimac River. Roads and Bridges.]

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-five.

AN ACT

To Require the Reconstruction of a Part of Rocks Bridge
Over the Merrimac River.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The County Commissioners for Essex
2 county are hereby authorized and required, within six
3 months after the passage of this act, to rebuild the
4 easterly abutment of Rocks bridge.

1 SECT. 2. Said commissioners are hereby authorized
2 to make such repairs on the two remaining wooden spans
3 of said bridge as the safety of public travel may demand,
4 or if in the judgment of said commissioners such repairs
5 are unwise they shall replace said wooden spans with a
6 new iron structure. The cost of all said rebuilding,
7 repairs or reconstruction shall be paid by the county of
8 Essex and said commissioners are authorized to borrow
9 such sums of money on the credit of said county as may
10 be necessary to carry out the provisions of this act.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
