AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for Expenses in Connection with Taking the Decennial Census.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION. 1. The sum of one hundred and
2 twenty-five thousand dollars is hereby appro-
3 priated to be paid out of the treasury of the
4 Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for
5 the payment of expenses in connection with tak-
6 ing the decennial census, as provided for by
7 chapter two hundred and twenty-four of the acts
8 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four, the
9 same to be in addition to the twenty-five thous-
10 and dollars appropriated by chapter three hun-
11 dred and forty-eight of the acts of the year
12 eighteen hundred and ninety-four.

(Appropriation 1894, \$25,000.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
