AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for Expenses in connection with the Extermination of Contagious Diseases among Horses, Cattle and other Animals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of fifty thousand dollars
2 is hereby appropriated to be paid out of the
3 treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary
4 revenue, for the purpose of meeting expenses in
5 connection with the extermination of contagious
6 diseases among horses, cattle and other animals,
7 during the year ending on the thirty-first day of
8 December, in the year eighteen hundred and
9 ninety-five. [Acts, 1894, chap. 491.]

(Appropriation 1894, \$35,000.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
