### AN ACT

Relative to Nominations to Public Office.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Any political party or combination of  
2 parties which at the preceding annual state or municipal  
3 election shall have cast for any office, state or municipal,  
4 as large a number of votes as equals the number of  
5 petitioners required to nominate for that office by nomi-  
6 nation papers, may nominate candidates for any such  
7 office, state or municipal, and shall be entitled to have  
8 the names of its candidates printed on the official ballot,  
9 subject only to such restrictions as apply to a party that  
10 casts three per cent. of the vote for governor.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
