AN ACT

To incorporate the Oakland Cemetery Association in the
Town of Dracut.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. O. F. Osgood, W. P. Varnum, J. G.
2 Eaton, George W. Clement, Joseph M. Wilson, their
3 associates and successors, are hereby made a corporation
4 by the name of the Oakland Cemetery Association, for
5 the purpose of establishing and perpetuating a place for
6 the burial of the dead in the town of Dracut, and shall
7 have all the powers and privileges and be subject to all
8 the duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in chapter
9 eighty-two of the Public Statutes, and all laws which
10 now are or hereafter may be in force relating to such cor-
11 porations.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation may hold real and personal
2 estate necessary and convenient for the purposes afore-
3 said not exceeding in amount five thousand dollars.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
