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**Commonwealth of Massachusetts.**

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-five.

**AN ACT**

Relating to the Removal of Persons and Property unlawfully occupying the Premises of the State Prison.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECT. 1. The warden of the state prison is hereby  
2 authorized to cause to be ejected and to be removed  
3 therefrom, without other process of law than is contained  
4 in this act, any person and any property unlawfully occu-  
5 pying or upon any portion of the state prison, or any  
6 portion of any building or land used in connection  
7 therewith.

1 SECT. 2. Any person who has suffered damage by the  
2 unlawful ejection or removal of person or property from

3 said premises may bring a suit, by an action of tort, in  
4 the superior court for the county of Suffolk, against<sup>r</sup> the  
5 Commonwealth to recover the amount of said damage  
6 within four years from the date of said ejection] or  
7 removal.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
