[Bill accompanying petition of the constables of the Municipal Court
of Boston.]

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-five.

AN ACT

Relative to the Tenure of Office of Constables of the Municipal Court of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Constables of the municipal court of the
2 city of Boston after appointment by the mayor shall
3 hold office during the pleasure of a majority of the
4 justices of said court. Said constables shall not be
5 required to renew their bonds annually, but may be re-
6 quired by the mayor to renew their bonds or give addi-
7 tional sureties at any time when in the opinion of the
8 mayor such bonds or sureties have become insufficient.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage
2 and shall apply to the constables now in office.
