### AN ACT

Relating to the Bridge over Charles River.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The bridge across Charles river which  
2 the Boston transit commission is authorized by chapter  
3 five hundred and forty-eight of the acts of the year  
4 eighteen hundred and ninety-four to build, shall be so  
5 built as to be not less than twenty-four feet above ordin-  
6 ary high water mark at the channel of said river, and to  
7 be not less than fifteen feet above the surface of Cause-  
8 way street, and to be not less than fifteen feet above the  
9 tracks on the Charlestown side of said river.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
