AN ACT

Relative to Exhibitions of the Game of Foot-ball.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any person who takes part in a game of
2 foot-ball, when such game is played in the presence of
3 persons who have paid an admission fee to witness the
4 same, or who promotes the playing of a game of foot-
5 ball when money is charged for admission to witness the
6 same, or who sells or offers for sale or has in his posses-
7 sion with intent to sell or offer for sale any ticket of
8 admission to witness a foot-ball game, or who, being a
9 student in an institution of learning, and while engaged
10 in a game of foot-ball, beats, strikes or intentionally
11 wounds or bruises another person engaged in playing
12 such game, shall be punished by fine not exceeding fifty
13 dollars for each offence.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
