Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-five.

AN ACT

To promote the Purity of the Public Service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No deputy sheriff, clerk of court or officer
2 in attendance upon any court in the county of Suffolk, or
3 employee whose salary is paid from the treasury of said
4 county, shall be an officer of any political caucus or a
5 member of any political committee or delegate to any
6 political convention.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
