AN ACT

To authorize the Mount Hermon Boys' School to hold additional Real and Personal Estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Mount Hermon Boys' School is
2 hereby authorized to hold real and personal estate, in
3 the manner and for the purpose set forth in its charter,
4 to an amount not exceeding two million dollars; pro-
5 vided that no lands hereafter acquired by said corpora-
6 tion shall be exempt from taxation, but this act shall not
7 affect the right of said corporation to hold real and per-
8 sonal estate, exempt from taxation, to the value of five
9 hundred thousand dollars as authorized by the provisions
10 of chapter one hundred and fifteen of the Public
11 Statutes.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
