### AN ACT

To exempt certain Town Halls from the Operation of the Law regulating the Construction of Buildings to be used as Theatres.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter three hundred  
2 and eighty-two of the acts of the year eighteen hundred  
3 and ninety-four shall not apply to town halls or public  
4 buildings under construction on or before the first day of  
5 October in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four,  
6 built of brick, and not over two stories in height.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
