AN ACT

Relative to the Feeding of Food Animals with Garbage,
Refuse or Offal.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Whoever knowingly feeds or has in his possession
2 with intent to feed to any food animal, except swine,
3 any garbage, refuse or offal collected by any city of
4 more than thirty thousand inhabitants, by contract or
5 otherwise, shall be punished by imprisonment in the jail
6 or house of correction not exceeding thirty days or by
7 fine not exceeding fifty dollars.
