AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Clerk of the Municipal Court
of the Brighton District of the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the clerk of the municipal
2 court of the Brighton district of the city of Boston shall
3 be one thousand dollars a year, to be so allowed from the
4 first day of January in the year eighteen hundred and
5 ninety-five.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
