### RESOLVE

Providing for Certain Repairs and Improvements at the  
State Prison.

1   *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding six  
3 thousand dollars, to be expended at the state prison at  
4 Boston, under the direction of the commissioners of pris-  
5 ons, for the following purposes, to wit: for repairing  
6 and altering the kitchen of the prison, a sum not exceed-  
7 ing three thousand dollars; for furnishing the houses of  
8 the warden and deputy warden, a sum not exceeding  
9 twenty-five hundred dollars; and for repairing said  
10 houses, a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars.
