RESOLVE

Relating to the Boundary Line between the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the State of New Hampshire.

1 *Resolved*, That the line agreed upon by the commis-
2 sioners on the part of New Hampshire and Massachusetts,
3 by their agreement dated June eighteen, eighteen hun-
4 dred and ninety-four, and referred to in the report of
5 said commissioners for this Commonwealth at the present
6 session of the legislature, be assented to on the part of
7 Massachusetts; and that when said line as therein de-
8 scribed shall have been run, marked by proper monu-
9 ments, and a map of the same, approved by said
10 commissioners for this Commonwealth, shall have been
11 filed in the office of the secretary of state, said line shall
12 be established as the boundary line between said state
13 and said Commonwealth from the boundary pine monu-
14 ment to the southwest corner of the state of New Hamp-
15 shire; and that said corner, being the corner where the
16 three states, viz.: Vermont, Massachusetts and New
17 Hampshire, meet at South Vernon, as agreed upon by
18 said commissioners for Massachusetts, commissioners of
19 Vermont and commissioners of New Hampshire by their
20 tripartite agreement, dated October twenty-six, eighteen

21 hundred and ninety-four, and referred to in said report,
22 be approved and assented to by Massachusetts; and that
23 said commissioners for Massachusetts be fully empowered
24 to carry out said agreements, and to run and map the
25 line aforesaid and to cause the same to be marked and
26 defined by suitable monuments, and to join Vermont and
27 New Hampshire in erecting a suitable corner monument
28 at the locality designated in said agreement.

29 This resolution shall take effect when said state of
30 New Hampshire shall have agreed to establish said line
31 and said state of Vermont shall have established said cor-
32 ner as her southeast corner, and information thereof shall
33 have been furnished the governor. His excellency, the
34 governor of this Commonwealth, is requested to transmit
35 copies of this resolve to his excellency, the governor of
36 New Hampshire, and to his excellency, the governor of
37 Vermont.
