## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-five.

### AN ACT

Concerning the Annual Expenses and Report of the Board of Gas and Electric Light Commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The board of gas and electric light  
2 commissioners may expend not exceeding three thou-  
3 sand dollars annually in procuring books, statistics and  
4 stationery and defraying expenses incidental and neces-  
5 sary to the discharge of their duties, and a sum not  
6 exceeding three thousand dollars in defraying the com-  
7 pensation and expenses of their clerk and for clerical  
8 assistance, and the same shall be assessed and recovered  
9 as now provided by law; *providing, however*, that their  
10 clerk shall not receive as compensation more than two  
11 thousand dollars a year.

1 SECT. 2. Thirty-five hundred copies of the report of  
2 the board of gas and electric light commissioners shall  
3 be printed annually as a public document on or before  
4 the assembling of the general court or as soon thereafter  
5 as possible.

1   SECT. 3. Chapter three hundred and fifty-one of the  
2 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one and so  
3 much of chapter three hundred and ninety-three of the  
4 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four as is  
5 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

1   SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
