The committee on Towns, to whom was referred the petition of the selectmen of Hyde Park that said town may be authorized to incur indebtedness for the purchase and improvement of land for park purposes (with House, No. 1197), report the accompanying Bill.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Hyde Park to issue Bonds, running for Thirty Years and Upwards, for the Purchase and Improvement of Land for Park Purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Hyde Park, for the purpose
2 of purchasing land in the vicinity of high rock for park
3 purposes and for improvements thereon, may borrow
4 twenty-one thousand dollars, and may issue bonds there-
5 for, payable in thirty equal annual instalments, the first
6 instalment to become due May first, eighteen hundred
7 and ninety-six. The bonds shall be dated May first,
8 eighteen hundred and ninety-five, shall bear interest at
9 the rate of four per cent. per annum, payable semi-
10 annually November first and May first of each year, and
11 shall be in denominations of five hundred dollars and one
12 hundred dollars each, but the provisions of chapter
13 twenty-nine of the Public Statutes as amended shall
14 otherwise apply to such indebtedness.

1 SECT. 2. The vote of the town of Hyde Park passed
2 on the twenty-eighth day of March, eighteen hundred and
3 ninety-five, authorizing the treasurer of the town to
4 borrow twenty-one thousand dollars for the park pur-
5 poses set out in section one of this act, is hereby con-
6 firmed and declared legal and valid.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by a majority vote of the voters of said town, present
3 and voting thereon, at a legal town meeting called for
4 the purpose within one year from its passage.
