RESOLVE

In favor of James N. Tolman.

1 *Whereas*, James N. Tolman, a messenger in the ser-
2 geant-at-arms' department, and who has been employed
3 therein as watchman, sergeant-at-arms' messenger and in
4 charge of the legislative document room for nearly fifty
5 years, is now afflicted with a disease which incapacitates
6 him from further service, and it may result fatally within
7 the current year, therefore

8 *Resolved*, That in recognition of his long and faithful
9 service, the sergeant-at-arms be allowed to continue
10 the said James N. Tolman on his pay-roll for the
11 term of one year from the date of the passage of
12 this resolve, which sum shall be paid out of the
13 treasury of the Commonwealth to the said James N.
14 Tolman monthly, and, in case of his death, the same sum
15 per month shall be paid to his widow to the end of the
16 year provided for by this resolve.
