RESOLVE

In favor of certain Veterans of the Town of East Bridgewater.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth the sum of one hundred
3 and twenty-five dollars each to Charles Drake, Horace
4 A. Ripley, Benjamin F. Bowman and Charles F. Bow-
5 man; said persons being veterans who served in the
6 United States army or navy in the war of the rebellion
7 to the credit of the town of East Bridgewater, and who
8 never received a bounty for said service.
