RESOLVE

In Favor of the Widow of Gilbert Cooke.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth, to the widow of Gilbert
3 Cooke, late a member of the house of representatives
4 from the fourteenth Worcester district, the sum of
5 seven hundred and fifty dollars, being the compensa-
6 tion to which the said Gilbert Cooke would have
7 been entitled had he lived until the close of the present
8 session of the general court.
