## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-six.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses  
of the Insurance Commissioner.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for  
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-  
6 ber in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six,  
7 to wit:—

8 For the salary of the insurance commissioner,  
9 thirty-five hundred dollars. [Acts 1890, chap.  
10 247.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$3,500.)

11 For the salary of the deputy insurance commis-  
12 sioner, twenty-five hundred dollars. [Acts 1887,  
13 chap. 214 ; 1888, chap. 84 ; 1895, chap. 81.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$2,500.)

14 For the salary of the actuary of the insurance  
15 commissioner, two thousand dollars. [Acts 1895,  
16 chap. 81.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$2,000.)

17 For the salary of the chief clerk of the insur-  
18 ance commissioner, two thousand dollars. [Acts  
19 1895, chap. 81.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$2,000.)

20 For the salary of the second clerk of the insur-  
21 ance commissioner, fifteen hundred dollars. [Acts  
22 1895, chap. 81.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$1,500.)

23 For the salary of the third clerk of the in-  
24 surance commissioner, twelve hundred dollars.  
25 [Acts 1895, chap. 81.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$1,200.)

26 For such additional clerks and assistants as the  
27 insurance commissioner may find necessary for  
28 the despatch of public business, a sum not exceed-  
29 ing nineteen thousand dollars. [Acts 1895, chap.  
30 81.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$17,500.)

31 For incidental and contingent expenses of the  
32 insurance commissioner, a sum not exceeding forty-  
33 five hundred dollars. [Pub. Stat., chaps. 115 and  
34 119 ; Res. 1856, chap. 74 ; Acts 1887, chap. 214 ;  
35 1888, chap. 84.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$4,500.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
